Client Interviewers	to work with clients to assess needs and situations, verify information, and determine appropriate assistance
Pantry Workers	to fill grocery orders, stock pantry shelves, and package food and hygiene items
Food Pick-Up Van Drivers	to pick up pantry items using NDSM van (requires moderate to heavy lifting)
Job Counselors	to help assess employment goals, identify job opportunities, prepare resumes, and set up job interviews
Receptionists	to answer telephone, field client inquiries, and facilitate the client application process
Computer Workers	to work with data entry, word processing, and/or spreadsheet applications
Clerical Assistants	to assist staff with clerical tasks, such as mailings and record keeping
Financial Assistants	to write checks and make deposits using Peachtree accounting software
